For Marathi and Hindi

Full paper should be typed in Microsoft Word in "Unicode" with font size- 14 for content, 16 bold for title and 14 bold for headings, having line spacing of 1.5 inch and 1 inch custom margin on all sides.

Word Limit : **1600-2500**

Page Limit : **4 to 5 pages**

Our reviewer team will evaluate the submitted research papers and give notification of acceptance or rejection. Only after you receive our e-mail about acceptance of the paper, you are required to make the necessary payment.
